Call for 2016-2017 Volunteers

Corporate Support

The Corporate Support Committee will solicit financial support for the ASSR 2017 Annual Symposium. In doing so, the Committee will foster existing professional relationships with organizations/corporations that have supported previous ASSR Symposia, and will seek out new potential supporters. The Committee will work closely with the ASSR Program Committee in accomplishing these goals and with the Ad-Hoc Hoc Louis A. Gilula, M.D. Mentor Committee to solicit financial support for the 2017 Mentor Program.

Membership

The Membership Committee will review applications for membership from applicants who are not members of ASNR or of any ASNR-managed specialty/regional society to assure that they fulfill the requirements for membership in the appropriate membership category.

Program

The Program Committee will plan and coordinate the scientific program for the ASSR 2017 Annual Symposium and the spine radiology-portion of the ASNR 54th Annual Meeting.

Rules

The Rules Committee shall interpret the ASSR Bylaws, and upon request from the Executive Committee, shall prepare and submit amendments to the Bylaws as specified in Article XIII of the ASSR Bylaws.

Ad-Hoc Awards

The Ad-Hoc Awards Committee shall select the best paper and scientific exhibit (poster) presentations at the ASSR 2017 Annual Symposium and the Best Spine Radiology presentation at the ASNR 54th Annual Meeting.

Ad-Hoc Clinical Practice

The Ad-Hoc Clinical Practice Committee, with the approval of the Executive Committee, shall be responsible for addressing issues that impact clinical practice largely via governmental agencies and legislative vehicles and in conjunction with related societies that also address these issues. This committee will work in conjunction with the ASSR Clinical Practice Committee.

Ad-Hoc Gold Medal Award

The Ad-Hoc Gold Medal Award Committee shall recommend up to two eligible candidates for the ASSR 2017 Gold Medal to the Executive Committee for approval at least 60 days prior to the ASSR 2017 Annual Symposium.

Ad-Hoc Louis A. Gilula, M.D. Mentor

The Ad-Hoc Louis A. Gilula, M.D. Mentor Committee shall foster student, resident, fellow, or junior faculty participation on spine-related research projects; shall seek to improve the quality and quantity of spine-related research projects/topics, and on spine-related research topics at national meetings and peer-reviewed journals. The Committee shall oversee the 2017 Louis A. Gilula, M.D. Mentor Award Program. The Committee shall work closely with the Program Committee to promote spine research within the Society.

Ad-Hoc Hands-on Spine Procedures Course

The Ad-Hoc Hands-on Spine Procedures Course Committee shall plan and coordinate the didactic and procedures lab skills portions of the Hands-on Spine Procedures Course tentatively scheduled for fall 2016 at a yet-to-be-confirmed location. The Committee will solicit financial support for the Course and most members of the Committee will serve as Course Faculty.

Ad-Hoc Informatics

The Ad-Hoc Informatics Committee shall create, monitor, and update the content of the ASSR website (www.TheASSR.org) and continually facilitates promotion of the Society and enhancement of its image. The Committee shall develop announcements and enforce policies regarding formatting of speaker presentations and online submission of such presentation materials.

Ad-Hoc Intersociety Relations and Collaborations

The Ad-Hoc Intersociety Relations and Collaborations Committee shall foster communication, collaboration and joint projects with spine related medical and surgical societies and groups such as the European Society of Neuroradiology.

Ad-Hoc Research and Education

The Ad-Hoc Research and Education Committee shall plan and propose for consideration by the Executive Committee projects to further the educational mission of the Society. The Committee shall help to implement these educational projects given further approval and funding by the Executive Committee.

Ad-Hoc Social Media

The Ad-Hoc Social Media Committee shall promote the ASSR and its activities, including the Annual Symposium, via social media platforms with the goal of raising awareness of diagnostic imaging and interventional spine radiologists in the advancement of the science, diagnosis and treatment of spine disorders.

Ad-Hoc Young Professionals

The Ad-Hoc Young Professionals Committee shall foster the membership and involvement of newly trained residents and fellows in the ASSR including service on committee.
